I have been performing as an artist (cellist) for 28 years. My career has taken me to many places and I have been blessed with experiences that have fed my soul and my music.

I am in an unusual situation - as a single mother of two beautiful girls, I've have had many rough periods - and yet it has always been important to me to share messages of hope with others. And so when the lights go down and the house is sound asleep I have been quietly, and carefully developing a broader sense of who I am, and what I can give as an artist.

*I have a CD coming out this spring with my group "Red Venus Blue Tango" called '**This is the Life**' where I am lead singer, songwriter, cellist, and pianist. My group "Red Venus Blue Tango" has a world feel, and have been hired in the past 5 or so years to represent the multi-cultural aspect of the city of Calgary, on behalf of the Telus Convention Centre, and the City of Calgary. We have travelled to sell our city to others places in the world. We have performed to enthusiastic audiences in Calgary, Toronto, Ottawa, twice in Washington DC (Canadian consulate), and New York. The response to our music and the music's subject matter has been extremely positive - I am excited to finally see all these years of creative energy brought to the public.

*Giving back to the community and to the world is one of my **greatest** passions. I was very proud when my eldest daughter turned 8, and decided to dedicate her birthday party to bringing a World Vision child into our lives. The children donated money to her first year with us, and (with thanks to my friend Brent VanDusen), played world drums in celebration - we'll be repeating this for my youngest daughter's 11th birthday!*

*It is my hope, that through my music, people feel loved and motivated to love. Inspired by this, I have recently written a song **Sending Love**. Sending Love will be launched as the Encore to my CD Release "This is the Life" slated for April 25th at the Grand Theatre in Calgary AB. Biography

Cellist, Singer, Songwriter, Composer, Arranger, Pianist, Poet

...her works are infused with classical training, global contemporary cabaret, a hint of avant-garde, a sense of 'other-worldliness,' and humor.

Originally from Vancouver, Morag has been many permutations of: cellist, singer, songwriter, composer, teacher, pianist and poet in **Calgary** for over **18 years**. Her studies at the **Banff Centre**, **University of Texas at Austin**, and **University of Calgary**, helped to build a solid foundation for her professional career.

VAD Ensemble, created in 1991, shows off Morag's ability as leader, soloist, chamber musician and arranger. Morag has performed with a number of orchestras, which include: the **Austin Symphony**, and **Calgary Philharmonic Orchestra**. She has played for musical productions: **West Side Story**, **The Phantom of the Opera** (*Live Ent. Inc. Touring Orchestra*), **Les Miserables** (*Mirvish Productions*), **Annie** (*Theatre Calgary*), **Beauty and the Beast** (*Theatre Calgary*), **Camelot** (*Live Nation, Theatre Calgary*), **Royal Winnipeg Ballet** and **National Ballet** touring Orchestras.

Morag performs for a wide variety of events such as: **One Yellow Rabbit's 25th Anniversary** with Calgary's Greek/world band **Rembetika Hipsters**. She has freelanced with celebrities: **Tony Bennett**, **Lyle Lovett**, **Johnny Mathis**, **Linda Ronstadt**, **Rod Stewart** and has recorded with artists: **Wil**, **Kristoph Franz**, **Jeff Landeen**, **Lin Elder**, **Jasmine Whenem**, **Jane Hawley**, and **Mike Stack**, and **Onalea Gilbertson**.

Lilies of the Field, a recording on which Morag is *composer, arranger, cellist, singer, and co-producer*, was *nominated* most "**Inspirational Album of the Year**" for the *Gospel Music Association of Canada's 29th Annual Covenant Awards*, 2007.

Creating original music and collaborating with other artists to bring their vision to life is one of Morag's great passions. Recent collaborations include: **Blanche** - a poetic song cycle by Onalea Gilbertson along with Jonathan Lewis (*Banff Centre*) **Why Freud Fainted** - music co-created by Playwright David Rhymer, Celene Yohemes (*Alberta Theatre Projects*) and the upcoming **Queen Lear** by Eugene Stickland (*Urban Curvz*).

Whether it be performing original compositions as cellist and singer, simultaneously accompanying herself with drums (*Springboard Dance Company's* vertical dance production of **Corvidae** by Trina Rasmusen), or using three different cello's and cello tunings, played standing & dancing to her composed soundtrack of five songs (*One Yellow Rabbit 2008 Summer Lab Intensive* - final performance, **Out of the Storm**)... Morag's creative inspiration has continually lead her to push boundaries of expression.

Morag has written, arranged, performed and expressed her talents as singer, songwriter, cellist, and pianist for the original Canadian folk improv group **Tsk**, and Parisian Moulin Rouge, French Art Song Duo, **She** with Onalea Gilbertson.

Working with film is one of Morag's true callings. Her music can be heard as recording artist in the Canadian Film Productions: **Opening Night**, **The Former Mrs. Butterfly**, **Beauty Crowds Me**, and the *Genie-nominated short*, **Claire**. She composed and recorded cello and piano in the sound score for *Nicole Tritter's* dance film, **Enticed**, and has been heard on *soundtracks for film, and music video* with composer **Bruce Leitl** at *Six Degrees*.

While Calgary group **Cielo** originally showcased her songs, it was **And so it goes** (now **Red Venus Blue Tango**) that took them on the road performing in the US and Canada (*Canadian Embassy - Washington DC - Alberta at the Smithsonian, and celebrating Alberta's 100th year, Alberta Scene - Ottawa*).

Red Venus Blue Tango is releasing its first CD, **This is the Life** in the spring of 2009. This recording features original songs by **Morag** and **Brent Van Dusen** (percussionist, composer, singer, pianist, and electronica) with **Jonathan Lewis** (violin and accordion). Recorded at Vancouver's **Bakerstreet Studios** and produced by amazing guitarist, singer, songwriter brother **Craig Northey**, mixed by **Russell Broom**, mastered by **Dave Horrocks**, and Cover Design created by *Juno Award winner* **Michael Wrycraft**.

When teaching her 30 cello students ages 4 - 60, and an adult cello choir **Good Vibrations**, Morag brings all the music home to her **Broadview Cello Studio**.
